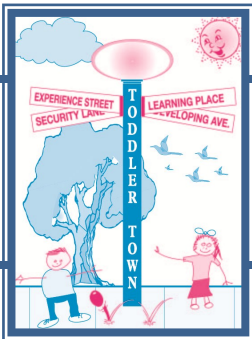

This is a reminder that our tuition payment policy went into effect February 1, 2013. Below are the dates that are associated with you payment option.

Payment Option #1: ½ tuition payment due on the 1st & final ½ due on 15th of the month.

Monday, March 4th - 1st ½ due; Monday, March 18th
Final ½ Due ~ Late Fee of \$15 charged at 6pm

Payment Option # 2: 4 Equal Payments due Each Monday

Monday, March 4, 2013, Monday, March 11, 2013
Monday, March 18, 2013, Monday, March 25, 2013
Late Fee of \$15 charged at 6pm

Payment Option #3: Payment in full on the 1st of the Month (Monday, March 4, 2013). Late Fee of \$15 charged at 6pm

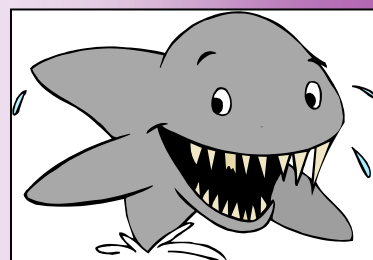
