Hello parents! Wow September went by so quickly we had so much fun! We got to learn a lot about each other this month and it was wonderful! Thank you parents who participated

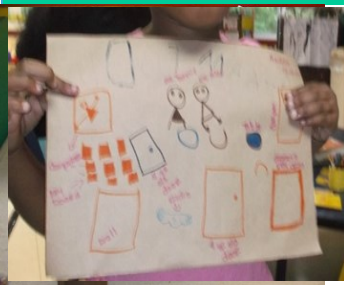
by submitting photos to our family tree, the children love talking about themselves and their family. October is now upon us and that means some fun will be planned. Some

Ms. Jaya and Mr. Shonn's Sharks Class 5-year-olds

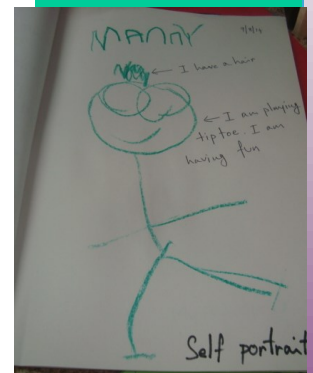
