Hello parents hope your February was just as fun as ours was! We learned about letter F & V, made fun Valentine's Day flowers in a vase, and made a

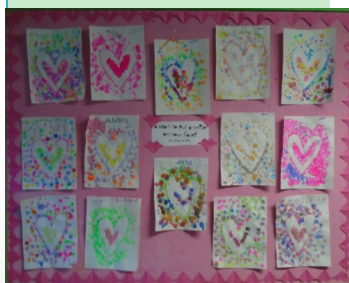
farm with some beautiful farm animals! This month looks to be just as exciting. We will celebrate Dr. Seuss's birthday, St. Patrick's Day, the letter M,
