Welcome September! We had so much fun pretending to be Ocean animals, Zoo animals; we discussed the importance of Hand-washing, learned about different kinds of feelings, and had fun playing a feelings game. 

What's New with Toddler Town?



1. Pick Up List: We have a new feature on our website that allows parents to add someone to the pick-up list when they are unable to pick up their child. You can now go to our website and complete the "Emergency Authorization Form" located on the right hand side of the page: https://toddlertowndaycare.formstack.com/forms/toddler_town_pick_up_form



- 2. <u>Parent Portal:</u> Parents can go to our website and be connected to the parent portal where they can view their child's account. This feature is located on the right hand side of the page under "Log In To Your Child's Account." Through this new feature, existing families can:
 - ➤ View information about their account, such as recent payments, ledger card history, time cards and immunization history.
 - > Change certain things, such as updating a phone or address
 - > Print reports like year-end statements, child time cards, etc.
 - ➤ Have the option to pay online from their phone, tablet or computer through integration with Tuition Express
- 3. **Phone Menu:** Don't forget about our new phone menu. Down below are the extensions according to classroom. When leaving a message, remember to state: Your Name, Your Child's Name, and a Call Back Number. If it is an emergency, do not hesitate to call again or speak to the director directly.
