Parents: As we are changing into a new season, please be sure to update your child's cubbie by placing the appropriate clothing items for the season.

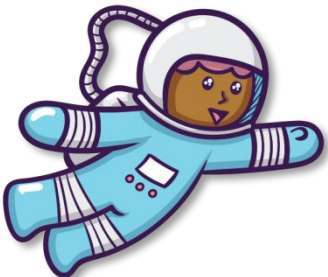
THE BEARS (4-5 Year Olds)
