SCHOOL & STRATEGIC OVERSIGHT (60 minutes)

1. Mosaica Report – including enrollment

Three resignations, two were teachers. Still looking for Spanish teacher. CSI testing window is sufficient, we won't need to re-do next years calendar. 11 new student teachers coming on. Did not gent enough interest in summer programs to get them organized this year. More specials teachers got their full licenses.

Student Council: \$89 Movie Night: \$210 Jeans Spirit Day: \$35

Dragon Breath Chilli Cookoff: \$1900!

2012 GT plan was useful to define early starter assignments so we won't lose funding on them in the future. TCAP 3rd graders goal of86.5% reading proficiency was exceeded: 89%. We beat all CSI schools and all TPAAK schools in Colorado and are in the top 5 of all Mosaica schools!

Discussed waiting list cutoff numbers. 41 middle school students enrolled right now.

2. Best of TPAAK:

9 out of the 15 students chosen in the Colorado Paver Projects were TPAAK. Our Young Chateauguay was a HUGE success for 3rd and 4th grades, 150 attended every night.

Barry Eastman: NY Life Insurance Stock Market Exchange Game: Of 5+ teams competing, TPAAK had 2 teams invited to Award Ceremony.

3. Marketing – Growing up Ft. Collins Posters are going out again for Fort Collins and North Loveland. Planning door hangers in geographic radium centered on the school. This is an edited form of our current flyer. GeoAdvertising to float us better on web searches, we are not yet to the first page. Good lead and tours going on, not certain about mailer or email. We will have more formal ideas next month.

Grants: Artworks grant is stalled awaiting specials teachers class plans and videos, as well as a few other small June releases of paperwork. Discussed several other grant options and ideas. Discussed local grants and curriculum grants for new programs and existing programs. Need some numbers from the treasurer to comple the Colorado Common Grant forms. Our intern is finishing up a calendar for grant submission deadlines. Discussed summer teacher gatherings to propose curriculum to be used with grant applications – mostly with specials teachers.

4. Inclement weather policy

We follow PSD days and policies. This year they made some odd choices that we had little choice but to follow. ACTION ITEM: Add explicit text to school policy documents explaining this.

5. Early literacy Project/Information

We are part of an literacy cohort grant, it gives us all new text books, tests and training for us. Diebles is moving to Diebles Next, we'll get needed hardware and software through this grant.

6. Fine Arts proposed budget

The Music teacher gave us her tiered needs and wants and talked about sound needs for the cafetorium. Discussed sources of money and grants and funding strategies. Dates are needed on the calendar to help promotional scheduling. Noted DonorsChoose.com site as a possible source of money.

7. PTLO report/questions

Questions and answers:

Will the board be giving out T-shirts again next year? Answer: Yes, to all students Will we be at Charter School 20th Anniversary event on June 3? Answer: no, too expensive.

Discussed an overview of how PTLO's funds fit into school funding process and what power the PTLO has vs. the Board with respect to these funds. Answer: We have influence and final say, but as a rule we (the Board) stay out of their decisions unless we need something.

8. Champions

Champions gave a presentation. Our association has been good and we plan on offering them again. We had a big jump in 2013-14 enrollment here and a very high re-enrollment rate. Discussed changes due to room changes next year.

9. Strategic Planning

Discussed IT infrastructure upgrade and school computer upgrades. We would like a better wide screen for Cafetorium presentations. Eric has a contact idea. Discussed the idea of a classroom "patron" to help with computer memory upgrade funding —It isn't very expensive on an individual classroom basis.

10. Budget Overview

Working on Paul Family presentations and Mosaica presentations about debt loading and future funding. We are working on curriculum grants, we've trimmed our marketing budget. We currently have a \$105K shortfall. With a deferral from Mosaica and some more fundraisers, we can be balanced.
