TREERUNNER ADVENTURE PARK ADDS A JUNIOR PARK FOR 2018 SEASON

TreeRunner Adventure Parks operate three aerial challenge parks with its fourth location opening this summer on the campus of Oakland University, Rochester, Michigan.

RALEIGH, NORTH CAROLINA, APRIL 2018 – TreeRunner Raleigh Adventure Park is excited to introduce a Junior Park for kids as an addition to the aerial challenge park it opened in 2017. Situated in a beautiful pine forest on the campus of the Raleigh-Cary Jewish Community Center, TreeRunner Adventure Park offers an exhilarating experience that suits most climbing ability levels. The park has added four new zip lines and unique challenge elements for climbers to explore this season.

“We host many fun and themed events throughout the season, including our ever-popular Glow Nights every Friday and Saturday night where we play upbeat music, hand out glow swag, and climb under the brilliant lights in the park,” says Erica Erway, Park Manager. “We will be adding exciting new themed events this year. “Our parks are great for individuals, families, groups, and now the little adventurers can participate too with our new Junior Park!”

TreeRunner Adventure Parks do not feature just one single aerial treetop trail but a selection of color-coded aerial trails of differing challenge levels, beginner through expert, that climbers choose from depending on their age or climbing experience. These trails consist of platforms installed in the trees which are connected by various configurations of cable, wood, and rope to form crossings of different kinds including the ever-popular zip lines. Climbers wear harnesses which are doubly secured to safety cables using the park's "always locked on" system of interlocking safety clips. Before venturing onto the trails climbers receive an interactive orientation and practice session.

TreeRunner Raleigh Adventure Park features 13 zip lines and seven aerial challenge trails which include three levels of difficulty. Guests will find unique and fun obstacles suspended in the trees, such as the “air-board,” a skateboard that is ridden through the treetops. The obstacle known as

the most difficult challenge in the park is the flying saucers, which may take several attempts to complete. This aerial challenge park offers 54 unique suspended elements to navigate while its new Junior Park allows those younger than seven to enjoy a tree adventure as well.

TreeRunner Raleigh Adventure Park is located on campus of the Raleigh-Cary Jewish Community Center at 12804 Norwood Road. The park's Spring season is now open and reservations are available for climbing and group appointments.

TreeRunner Adventure Parks was founded in 2015 by a team of Michigan Entrepreneurs. With the addition of West Bloomfield, TreeRunner Parks now owns and operates three aerial adventure parks nationally - two in Michigan, and one in North Carolina. Expected to open in the summer of 2018, a fourth TreeRunner Park is currently being constructed on the campus of Oakland University in Rochester, Michigan.
