In 2017 the Rye YMCA was approached by UVAIRx Inc. about installing on a trial basis, their “continuous disinfection” technology in 2 of our higher use program areas (child watch and spinning studio) with the hope of improving overall air quality in those spaces. As part of the trial, a “before and after swab test” was conducted.

The “before test” showed generally a modest presence of pathogens and in the “after test” (after the UVAIRx machines were on for a few days) showed a 100% removal of any pathogens (CFU’s) that existed on the surfaces. All swabs were witnessed by our staff that sent them directly to an independent lab for analysis.

The UVAIRx machines are mounted as sconces and will remain in place to insure long term protection against the possibility that dangerous pathogens that might be introduced in these areas.

We are now considering what other areas of the Y could benefit from this technology, including the pool and fitness areas.
