Admission Guidelines

After the interest form is reviewed, an application link specific to the union program will be provided. You must only use that application link, as it will ensure that the appropriate benefits are connected to your file. Going straight to Franklin's general application will slow down your enrollment.

Tuition/Fees and Financial Aid

- Tuition Cost is just \$200 per credit hour for the RN to BSN programs.
- Prospective Students must complete their Free Application for Federal Student Aid and any verification steps required.
 - Students can utilize their employer's tuition reimbursement if available.

Academic Advising

- Eligible, accepted Students MUST attend an online group registration event and opt to self-register in their student portal each trimester.
 - Students MUST enroll for at least 6 credits per trimester.

Who is Eligible?

The RN-BSN discounted program is open to union members in good standing, who are full dues-paying members or retiree members, and their families who meet the institution and program-specific admission and eligibility requirements outlined above. Families are children (or stepchildren), grandchildren (or step-grandchildren), spouses, domestic partners, financial dependents, siblings and parents, including in-laws. Additional family members may qualify. Check with your union to confirm.
