

Ob Schedule for testing

Initial OB Visit	Prenatal lab work with HIV, Antibody screen and Varicella titer CF screen(optimally should be completed prior to conception) Ultrasound if medically necessary
10-13 weeks	Genetic US and lab work for Trisomy 21- offered
15-20 weeks	Alpha-Fetal Protein- Quad Screen-offered
18-22 weeks	Ultrasound with Maternal Fetal Medicine- mandatory
20 weeks	Register for prenatal classes
26-28 weeks	1 hour GTT and HCT- Begin prenatal classes
28 weeks	Rhogam injection if indicated OB visits every 2-3 weeks
32 weeks	Register with SMH and for Epidural
35-37 weeks	Group B strep Culture- Third Trimester STD screen Discuss post partum birth control options
36 weeks	Weekly OB visits begin
40 weeks+	Bi- weekly Non Stress tests Weekly AFI Ultrasound

Testing for Advanced Maternal age (35 years and older)

These tests are offered and might involve a visit with the a Maternal Fetal Medicine Specialist

First Visit	Genetic Counseling
9-12 weeks	CVS- examine placental tissue for chromosomal/genetic disease
10-13 weeks	Nuchal Translucency, downs syndrome screening, hcg, PAPPA
16-20 weeks	Alpha-Fetal Protein QUAD screening
14-20 weeks	Amniocentesis- test amniotic fluid for chromosomal/genetic diseases
18-22 weeks	Ultrasound with Maternal Fetal Medicine
34-36 weeks	Biweekly Non Stress testing Weekly AFI Ultrasound

Other Testing

with a history of previous gestational diabetes, family history of diabetes; obesity;large babies

20 weeks	1 hour Glucose tolerance test
26-28 weeks	1 hour Glucose tolerance test repeated if 1 st screen is normal

Rh Negative women

26-28 weeks	Antibody screen Rhogam administered within 10 days of antibody screen Rhogam earlier if CVS/Amnio done; bleeding during pregnancy or trauma

History of previous High blood pressure/pre-eclampsia; hypertension

First visit	baseline PEP labs, 24 hour urine
32 weeks	if hypertension, bi-weekly NST and weekly AFI

History of genetic disorders/diseases; certain medical problems; previous fetal demise

First visit	Maternal Fetal Medicine/genetic counseling Blood tests according to disease and/or disorders
