CT SITE OPTIONS

-Head (tip of the nose to C2/3)

- Patient is positioned prone, tail first
- Soft tissue and bone study

-Submandibular (midbrain to C5)

- Patient is positioned prone, tail first
- Soft tissue and bone study

-Neck (mid-cerebellum to below shoulder joint)

- Patient is positioned prone, tail first
- Soft tissue and bone study

-Thorax (below shoulder joint to end of lungs)

- Patient is positioned prone, tail first
- Soft tissue and bone study (lung window optional)
- Includes arteriogram and venogram

-Abdomen (caudal heart to caudal pelvis)

- Patient is positioned prone, tail first
- Soft tissue and bone study
- Includes arteriogram and venogram

-TL Spine (T3 to S1)

- Patient is positioned supine, tail first
- Soft tissue and bone study
- Does NOT include entire thorax and abdomen; images are collimated down to focus on spine only

-Pelvic Limbs (cranial pelvis through digits)

- Patient is positioned prone, tail first
- Soft tissue study
- Useful for soft tissue swelling and/or mass

-Thoracic Limbs (shoulder through digits)

- Patient is positioned supine, tail first
- Soft tissue study
- Useful for soft tissue swelling and/or mass



-Joint (choose one of the following: shoulder, elbow, carpus, hip, stifle, tarsus)

- Positioning depends on requested joints
- Bone study
- All joint studies are bilateral (i.e., if shoulder joint is requested, both shoulders will be included in exam)
- Joint studies are collimated down to focus on joints only
- Bilateral orthopedic studies may be attempted under sedation*

-Solitary Mass (covers mass in question ONLY)

- Patient is positioned prone, tail first
- Soft tissue and bone study (lung window optional; dependent on location of mass)
- Useful when a mass bridges two sites
